Spoke the Hub's LOCAL PRODUCE mini-Festival is a grass roots, cultural "green market" featuring local Brooklyn performing and teaching artists of all genres. This annual spring bacchanal is a **FREE, family friendly event** which takes place on Union Street between 5th and 6th Avenues, both indoors and outdoors.

Starting at noon, street activities include participatory community arts projects with **KOKO/NY** and **Open Source Gallery**; a skateboard "clinic" with **Homage Skateboard Academy**; martial arts demonstrations will include presentations by **Aikido of South Brooklyn, Raizes do Brasil Capoeira** and **Randolf James' Karate Dojo** students.

Spoke the Hub's **Young Artists**, will be featured at around 2pm under a big top tent pitched in front of the Spoke the Hub Re:Creation Center; in addition to STH's own ballet,, hip hop and tap students, additional youth groups will include students from the **Brooklyn Conservatory of Music, the Gowanus Wildcats, Koin & Company Hip Hop Dancers, Christina Reaves Students**

On the adult professional dance showcase at 4:30pm, performers will include **Brooklyn Tango Demonstration & Lesson, Mikki Tuesday's International Affair (Hip Hop), Lori Belilove's Isadora Duncan Dance Company, Luiza Karnas (Tap Dance), Charles Moore Dance Company (African), Kwabs Dance Company (Soca), and Lynn Neumann/Artichoke Dance Company (Modern Dance), Kaina Quenga (Polynesian Dance) and Brooklyn Swings Swing Dance Demonstration.**

7pm to 10pm

Following the adult professional showcase, outdoor festivities move indoors at 6:00pm for **LOCAL PRODUCE's** first vegetarian **Donors' Banquet** created by **Chef Nubian** followed by a **Brooklyn Swings** swing dance lesson and live jazz music with **Art Lillard** and his "**Blue Heaven**" sextet. For desert, **Brooklyn Swings** also will teach a Blues dance workshop with live music by **Michael Hill** and **Irving Louis Lattin** and open dancing to close out the evening.

Come join Spoke the Hub for another uplifting day of fun in the sun, full of music, dance, fresh air and plants!
